BACKGROUND:

Presenter: Jason Sweet and Rodrigo George, Bonneville Power Administration

Summary: Bonneville will provide an update on the Fish and Wildlife Direct Program's

expense and capital budgets for Fiscal Year (FY) 2025, along with past

reported spending levels for FY 2024.

Relevance: Bonneville's *direct program* implements the Council's Fish and Wildlife

Program and project-level recommendations. There are currently over 300 ongoing projects, most of which have been reviewed and recommended by the Council. These projects address mitigation for the impacts of hydro-

electric dams to fish and wildlife in the Columbia River basin.

Mitigation also occurs via the Council's Fish and Wildlife Program through the *reimbursable program* which includes the capital construction and operations and maintenance occurring on-site at the dams, as well as through actions called for in the Program that are directly *implemented by the agencies* that manage and operate the federal and non-federal dams, such as actions related to flow management and water quality. Those expenditures are not addressed in the direct program start of year budget.

Workplan: Program implementation: Tasks A (Project review and implementation); H (Implementation of the Council's Fish and Wildlife Program).

Background: The Council received a letter from Bonneville regarding their Fiscal Year 2025 Start of Year budget information dated November 4, 2024.

Bonneville's FY 2025 direct program expense budget is \$302,640,015 and \$24,862,562 for capital for a total overall planning budget of \$327,502,577. Attached is the letter to Chair Allen. Also attached is a table with project-specific budget information. The staff appreciate receiving this detailed information.

The letter notes that consistent with past practice and experience, Bonneville uses planning budgets that are a little higher than the forecasted spending budget because there is usually some underspending based on variable environmental conditions, permitting constraints and other legitimate reasons that occur with a large and complicated environmental mitigation program. This practice in turn ensures that overall, and across the Program, as much of the available annual program budget as possible is used for project implementation.

The staff is currently reviewing this information and will provide any observations to state staff and Council members.

RE: Bonneville's Fiscal Year 2025 Start of Year Budget Information

Dear Chairman Allen:

The purpose of this letter is to provide the Northwest Power and Conservation Council (Council) with notice of Bonneville Power Administration's (Bonneville) Fish and Wildlife Program planning budget for federal fiscal year (FY) 2025.

The start of year (SOY) budget shown below reflects F&W Program planning status as of October 1, 2024. Individual SOY project budgets for FY2025 are consistent with Bonneville's budget commitments in applicable agreements, and all SOY budgets have been uploaded into the contract management system, cbfish.org.

Our total F&W Program-level FY2025 SOY planning budget is set at \$327,502,577, which includes \$302,640,015 for expense, and \$24,862,562 for capital. Those same values for FY2024 SOY were \$324,346,736 which included \$297,474,498 for expense, and \$26,872,238 for capital (table 1). Project-specific budget information can be found in the attached excel spreadsheet. Consistent with past practice and experience, Bonneville uses a working budget that exceeds the start of year planning budget to ensure that, overall and across the F&W Program, as much of the available annual program budget is used for project implementation as possible. We are also continuing to provide monthly updates of project specific budget levels and expenditures to Patty O'Toole for use by Council Members and staff.

In addition, \$1.8M is planned for fish screens in FY25 based on the priorities recommended by the Asset Management Subcommittee.

Based on FY22 financial results, \$50M of the Rates Distribution Clause (RDC) was allocated to non-recurring maintenance needs of existing Fish & Wildlife mitigation assets that (i) BPA anticipates would otherwise need to be addressed during future rate periods and (ii) will result in avoidance of those costs in future rate periods.

This \$50M was split evenly between the Fish and Wildlife and Lower Snake programs and are a distinct funding source separate from our Fish & Wildlife Program. In addition, FY23 financial results, \$30M of the Rates Distribution Clause (RDC) was also allocated to Fish and Wildlife program. These funds are being budgeted and expended over several years and must be separated from current year rate-funded start of year program budgets.

As this fiscal year begins, Bonneville expects there is potential for additional projects to be added to the Program in FY25 as regional agreements currently in development are finalized.

Bonneville's Fish and Wildlife Division remains focused on continuing a disciplined approach to managing the F&W Program. We are closely tracking and reporting progress on budget execution by reviewing expenses on a monthly basis. We will continue to keep Council staff updated on expenditures in our monthly coordination meetings.

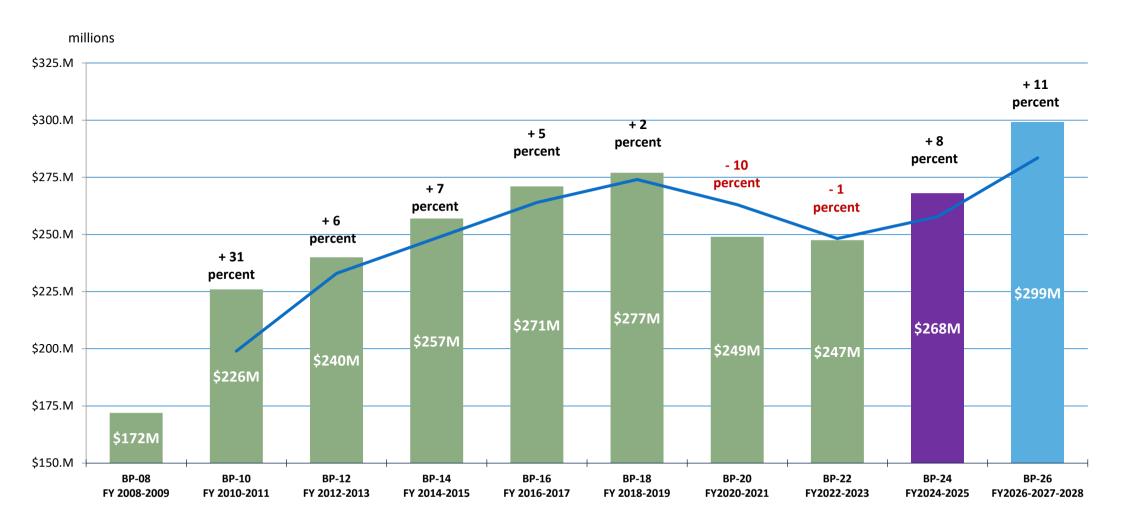

Fish & Wildlife EXP Funding Level Trends

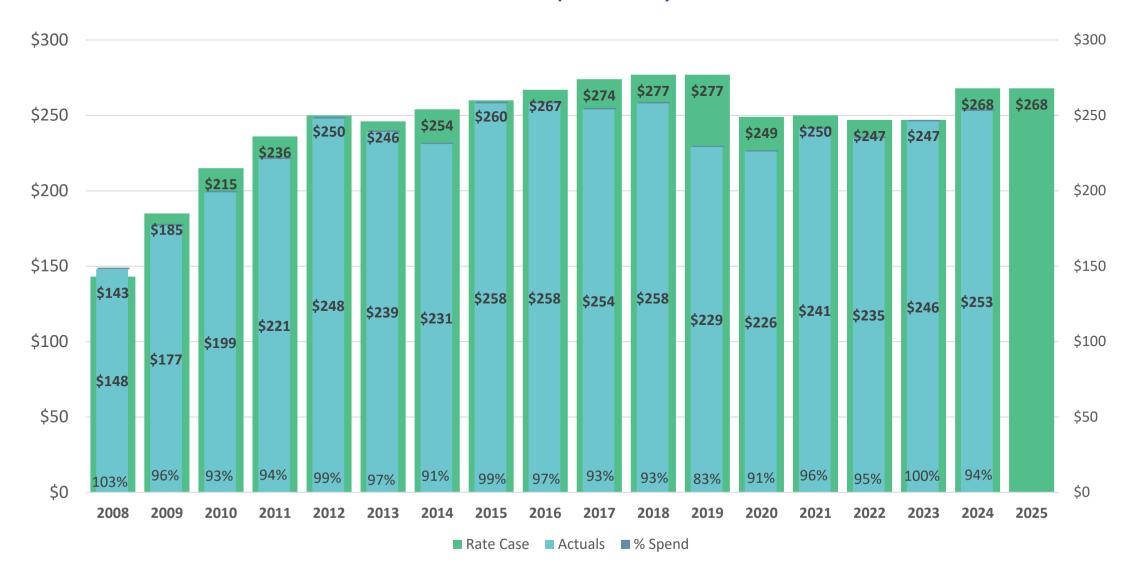
FY08/09 - FY26/27/28 Rate Case Levels

FY08-FY24 Actuals to Rate Case with % Execution (in millions) AVG=95%



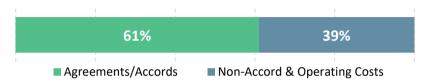


FY25 F&W Direct Program Budgets

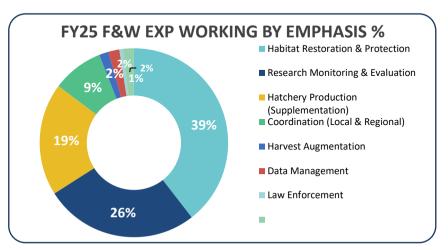


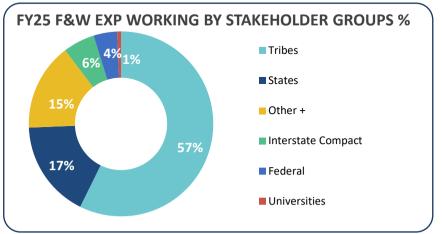

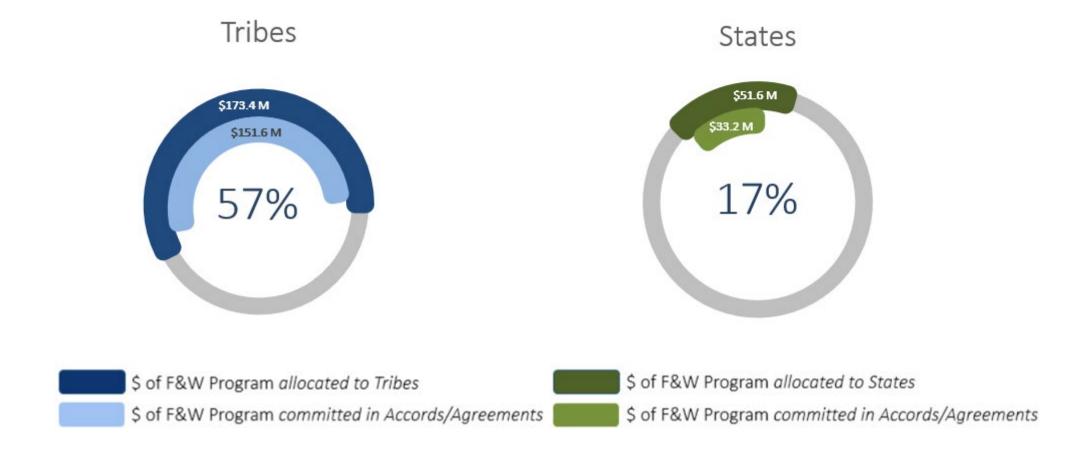

FY25 Budget Summary

- Based on BP24 IPR Cost Projections, BPA implemented an 8.7% increase in overall fish and wildlife costs at the program level for FY24 and FY25
- This was the largest percentage increase in projected F&W Program costs since 2012
- The estimated cost increase stemmed from inflationary pressure on the cost of materials, equipment and staffing across the Fish and Wildlife Program, new fish and wildlife obligations, and necessary investments in existing mitigation assets
- Bonneville implemented a 4.4% increase to all projects that did not have a previous commitment to annual budget adjustments
- Increased budget for non-routine asset management for hatcheries, irrigation fish screens, and lands
 - Does not include the additional \$50M in non-routine hatchery O&M implemented through the FY22 Reserve Distribution Clause
 - Does not include an additional \$30M allocated through the FY23 Reserve Distribution Clause

- To balance risk of overspending and underspending budgets, Bonneville will continue to refine our business management practices to monitor through the year and adjust as warranted
- In partnership with the Council, Bonneville will continue to focus and emphasize the program achievements that directly benefit fish and wildlife species
- Bonneville will work to refine protocols to share information with the Council and staff regarding project changes
