# Staff and Member tasks when recommendation period closes

- Post recommendations, request public comment on the recommendations.
- Share link with members: <u>read recommendations</u>
- Staff typically develops summaries of the *recommendations*, identifies issues.
- Hold work sessions to review the summaries, discuss the issues.
- Once *comments* are in, post and share with members. Incorporate into summaries and discuss issues, develop options for amendment.
- Draft amendments for amending the Program





#### Columbia River Basin Fish and Wildlife Program

The Council invites recommendations for amendments to its Fish and Wildlife Program.

#### About the amendment process

The Council amends its Columbia River Basin Fish and Wildlife Program every five years based largely on recommendations from the federal and state fish and wildlife agencies and the region's Indian tribes. Other federal and state agencies, the Bonneville utility customers and other regional utilities, other river users, local governments, and the general public may also submit program amendment recommendations that the Council must consider.

The current version of the Program is the <u>2014 Program</u> with a <u>2020 Addendum</u>, plus more than 50 separate <u>subbasin plans</u>.

- 4. They'll also be contacted when all recommendations are made public (shortly after April 17 deadline).



### Submit a recommendation: **Council staff side**

- Staff review, organize, and prepare recommendations received. 1.
- 2. When a new recommendation is received, staff assign (for internal organization):
  - Category (federal, state, tribe, environmental group, utility, individual, etc.) a.
  - One or more tags (generally match Program topics/themes) b.
  - Administrative notes (optional) С.
- 3. At the close of the recommendation period, an administrative record ID is assigned to each recommendation. All recommendations will then be published at nwcouncil.org/amend (next slide shows example from 2018).
