**Subject:** Discussion of Fish and Wildlife Division Work Plan for 2006

When the Committee reviewed the Division's proposed work plan in February, Chairman Karier proposed specific revisions to the work plan in the areas of research, monitoring and evaluation and data management. At last month's Council meetings, both the committee and the Council discussed tasks in these areas in more detail.

We reviewed more specific tasks for reviewing and prioritizing monitoring and evaluation in the Program. These tasks are incorporated into the "rolling issue memo" for the 2007-2009 project selection process as well. These tasks cover data management as well.

We have also provided a draft guidance document for monitoring and evaluation in the Program for discussion with the Committee and Council for referral for regional and ISRP review.

Another area of our work to discuss with you is the completion of data verification for the AHA database. We expected to contract for assistance with that effort. However, NOAA's hatchery reform initiative is conducting the same work and we are coordinating with NOAA's staff on contractor to combine our efforts. We expect to have a more definite work plan from them this week and will be ready to discuss that schedule with the Committee. That topic is also on the Council agenda.

The project selection process for 2007-2009 is on schedule. We are conducting the Mainstem/Systemwide proposal review in coordination with CBFWA and Bonneville through April with a goal of bringing the committee initial recommendations in May.

There are three attachments: Our division work plan as presented in February, Chairman Karier's proposed revisions and a summary of major fish and wildlife agenda items in 2006.
