SUBJECT: Briefing on Fish and Wildlife Division Work Plan for 2007

PURPOSE:

This agenda item is for the Committee discussion of progress on the Fish and Wildlife Division 2007 Work Plan. The work plan is attached.

DISCUSSION

The major focus of the divisions work for the first quarter of 2007 has been on preparing for the opening of the Fish and Wildlife Program for amendment in October of this year. Staff has developed a schedule and the defined the process for this effort and has initiated efforts with regional partners to the major issues. Major tasks have included:

- Organizing the "Science Policy" forum for high level discussions about major scientific issues in the Program and how they affect management decisions.
- Identifying additional staff-led evaluations of Program strategies.
- Initiating development of conceptual provincial biological objectives to be proposed as Program amendments.
- Regional outreach and the development of the amendment process.
- Mainstem amendment implementation and participation in several mainstem regional forums.
- Completion of review of fish abundance data.

Staff also continues to support the independent scientific review of the program and participate in regional forums on monitoring and evaluation and data management. Additionally, staff has devoted a significant amount of time in dealing with issues related to the FY 2007 - 2009 Bonneville Fish and Wildlife Program Budget.
