SUBJECT: Written findings and responses to recommendations and comments to complete the Fish and Wildlife Program amendment process

The agenda for the March Council meeting in Eugene includes a decision to approve the document that brings to a close that amendment process that led to the 2014 Fish and Wildlife Program. This document is often referred to as “the findings”, although more precisely it includes the explanations for how the Council responded to recommendations and comments throughout the amendment process, and includes findings on any recommendations not adopted.
