- Adaptive management (research) program measure:
 - The Council will, with federal and state fish and wildlife agencies and tribes review and update its research plan every three years beginning in 2014.
 - The review will begin with an update of how previous research funds were allocated to particular categories and critical uncertainties. The Independent Scientific Review Panel and the Independent Scientific Advisory Board will assist with updating the critical uncertainties, taking into account evolving topics and reporting on the results of past research.
 - Each step of this update will include opportunities for public input. This process will give consideration to critical uncertainties submitted during the program amendment process.
