**SUBJECT: Seattle City Light Integrated Resource Plan**

### **BACKGROUND:**

**Presenter:** Aliza Seelig, Manager of Resource Planning, Forecasting and Analysis at Seattle City Light

**Summary:** Aliza Seelig will brief the Council on Seattle's recently-completed 2018 Integrated Resource Plan Progress Report. Ms. Seelig's presentation will cover the unique characteristics and challenges faced by City Light as an all-hydro utility with policy guided by the city's mayor and a city council. The 2018 IRP focused on energy efficiency, how best to meet Washington requirements for renewable resources and conservation, and the utility's role in reducing greenhouse gas emissions. Ms. Seelig will also identify upcoming issues for City Light and will recommend topics for future Council analysis on key issues.

**Relevance:** Individual utility plans are key elements of the regional picture on energy resources and issues.
