SUBJECT: Continue discussion of the Fish and Wildlife Program amendments

BACKGROUND:

Presenter: Staff

Summary: The purpose of the May 6 and 7 work sessions are to review the preliminary draft of the amendments (pre-decisional document)

Relevance: The Council is in the midst of its Fish and Wildlife amendment process. The Council called for recommendations to amend its Program in May of 2018 and recommendations were due on December 13, 2018.

Workplan: Related to the Program amendment process described in the Fish and Wildlife Division workplan

Background:
