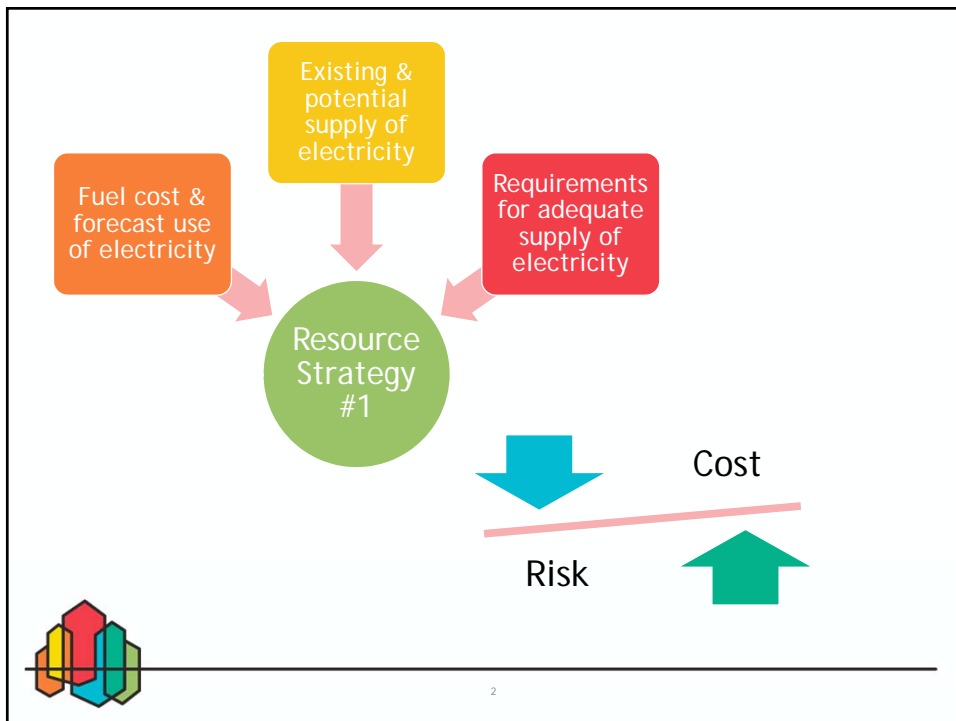
Relevance: The resource strategy is a primary component called out in the Power Act of a power plan.

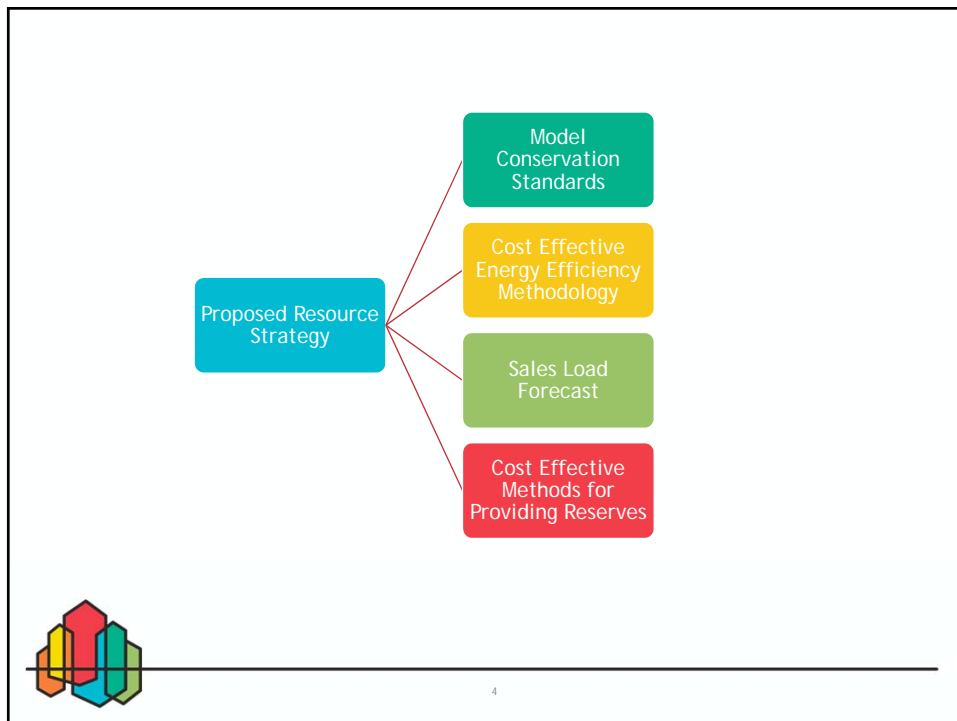
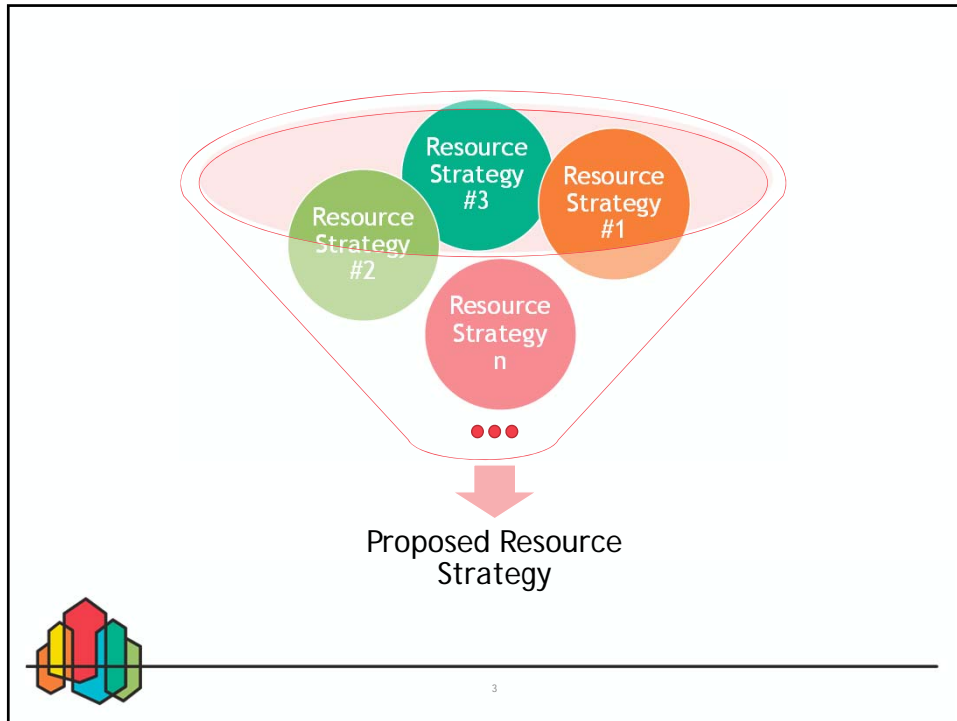

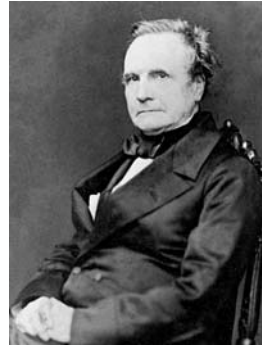
