- **SUBJECT:** Recommendation to appoint Dr. Terry Morlan to the Independent Economic Analysis Board

**PROPOSED ACTION:** Consistent with the Independent Economic Analysis Board (IEAB) Charter, staff recommends the Council appoint Dr. Terry Morlan to the Council's IEAB, for a term of four years, to serve along with the other four current sitting members of the IEAB.

## BACKGROUND

Members of the Pacific Northwest Regional Economic Conference (PNREC) Board, have assessed eleven candidates for the IEAB. The PNREC screening committee used the following criteria for their evaluation:

- Academic and/or research credentials in economics and/or the application of economics to natural resource policy decision-making.
- Evidence of being an "independent" professional in the area of Northwest fish, wildlife and related ecosystem issues. That is, IEAB members should be free of conflicts of interest or bias.
- Some familiarity with Northwest fish and wildlife or natural resource issues is desirable.
- A diversity of expertise among board members within the sub-disciplines of economics.

One candidate was ranked highest by the PNREC review committee, Dr. Terry Morlan. Dr. Morlan is the former director of the Council's Power Division and was a long serving member of the Council's staff until his retirement.
